Public Meeting—Building Permit Fee Update

To offset the costs of providing Building Code services, municipalities are permitted to charge fees for building permit applications and inspections of buildings. The Municipality of Clarington is reviewing its building perm it fees, within the building by-law, as a requirement under the Building Code Act.

It is projected to cost the Municipality of Clarington \$3,667,600 in 2024 to provide Building Code services.

In accordance with the provisions of the Building Code Act, the Municipality is proposing an increase of 8.99 p er cent for building permit fees and inspection fees as of March 1, 2024. This represents an increase from \$15.3 3 to \$16.71 per square metre for a single-family dwelling.

This will ensure that building permit revenue covers all direct and indirect costs to the Municipality in deliverin g these services, based on projected trends and building data. It also contributes to the reserve fund, which woul d be used to maintain services during an economic downturn.
